Exhibition Opens at Jack Rutberg Fine Arts October 21 - December 23, 2006

Los Angeles, CA - Opening with a reception Saturday, October 21 from 6:00 to 9:00 PM, Jack Rutberg Fine Arts at 357 North La Brea Avenue in Los Angeles presents "**NUDE**," an exhibition of paintings, drawings, prints & sculpture.

This exhibition, with over 100 works, spans more than a century and includes a wide stylistic range as example by contemporary artists David Hockney and Raymond Pettibon, Pop artist Tom Wesselmann, Surrealists Roberto Matta and Joseph Cornell and early modernists Arshile Gorky and Henri Matisse, along with Impressionists such as Pierre Auguste Renoir.
